**STIPULATION OF
SETTLEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Petitioner commenced this Article 78 proceeding on February 24, 2020, contesting her disqualification and removal from the Police Officer civil service eligible list, effectuated by vote of the Civil Service Commission in its meeting held on October 24, 2019; and

WHEREAS the eligible list from which Petitioner was disqualified expired with the establishment of a new Police Officer civil service eligible list; and


WHEREAS a new Police Officer eligible list, was established on January 23, 2020, and the Petitioner is listed as a candidate on that eligible list; and


WHEREAS, the parties now desire to settle this matter without any further litigation, and without any admission of finding of fault or liability;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED, by and between the undersigned that:

1. The Petitioner's disqualification from the Police Officer eligible list, effectuated by the October 24, 2019 determination of the Civil Service Commission, is vacated.
2. Petitioner agrees to dismiss this action in its entirety and with prejudice.
